EDN Announces New Online Pitching Sessions Coming in Fall



EDN - European Documentary Network is hosting a new round of online pitching sessions. With these sessions, pitching documentary projects to financiers is just one click away. The unique format features two new sessions in Fall 2017, each focusing on a different theme. The first session concentrates on docs for young audiences while the second one is specializing on rough cuts.

The EDN Online Pitching Sessions offer filmmakers an easy and innovative way to enter the market and get access to international financiers. The format was introduced in 2010 and has since been an important stepping-stone for many quality documentaries.

“Meeting funders and distributors face-to-face still remains essential. When considering that this is usually time consuming and requires travelling, the EDN online pitching sessions are a smart and refreshing opportunity. I pitched twice there and got introduced to funders I didn’t know”, says Christian Popp from YUZU Productions.

EDN collaborates with a vast network of commissioning editors, sales agents and film funds in order to find the relevant financiers for projects pitched during the sessions. Therefore filmmakers receive concrete market feedback relevant to their particular ideas.
